5. The Student/ Guide should ensure that there is no plagiarism. The report may be rejected if the same is detected at any time.
6. Only online submitted report will be accepted. Reports sent in hard copy or sent by email will not

7. Before beginning the research a clearance from an appropriately constituted (as per ICMR Ethical guidelines) Institutional Ethics Committee (IEC) / or Institutional Animal Ethics Committee (IAEC) should be obtained, as applicable. Without the ethical clearance the report will not be accepted. Also note that studies involving stored samples/ human biological materials/ retrospective analysis of records/ surveys etc., also require clearance from IEC.
8. The research carried out by the student must be in compliance with ICMR's "Ethical Guidelines for Biomedical Research on Human Participants, 2006" which may be downloaded from ICMR website (http://icmr.nic.in/ethical_guidelines.pdf).
9. In case it is felt that research belongs to exempt category a "certificate of exemption from ethical review" may be obtained from the IEC.
10. If the Ethics Committee does not approve the student's project OR does not hold a meeting or the student does not have the approval due to any reason, he/ she should not carry out his/ her research till he/ she receives the approval. Report on research carried out without ethical approvals shall not be accepted.
11. If the ethics committee composition is not as per ICMR guidelines, the completed report of the student may not be accepted by ICMR.
12. Certificate and stipend will be issued only when the reports are approved after a scientific review.
13. ICMR reserves the rights to approve/ reject a report or ask for a revised report.

One of the main objectives of the University is to promote research activities in the University and also affiliated colleges. In this regard University had invited applications for financial assistance for conducting of advanced research projects for the year 2015-16. University had received 366 research proposals. The University had earmarked Rs.5.00 crores in its budget estimate for the year 2015-16 for this purpose. In order to meet this expenditure the concerned Subject Experts as suggested by the concerned BOS PG chairpersons and the Expert Committee comprising of all the BOS PG chairpersons have scrutinized the proposals and shortlisted them based on the criteria set out by the University. Such of the proposals which have fulfilled the norms have been recommended by the Expert Committee for sanction of grants.

The Syndicate in its 116th meeting held on 16th December 2015 has approved to sanction the grant-in-aid as per the recommendations of Expert Committee for 159 selected proposals in medical, dental, pharmacy, ayurveda, nursing, physiotherapy, allied health sciences and BNYS faculties for the year 2015-16.

As per the decision of the Syndicate the following orders are made.

Pursuant to the approval of the Syndicate, sanction is hereby accorded for release of grant-in-aid amounting to Rs. 2,55,000-00 (Rupees Two lakhs fifty five thousand only) towards research proposal "DETECTION OF HUMAN PAPILLOMA

VIRUS AND EPSTEIN BARR VIRUS IN SUBJECTS OF ORAL LEUKOPLAKIA BY POLYMERASE CHAIN REACTION (PCR)." furnished by Dr Asha R Iyengar, Prof and Head, Oral Medicine and Radiology, DA Pandu Memorial RV Dental College, CA-37, 24Th main, JP Nagar, 1st phase, Bangalore-78 for the year 2015-16. The Grant-in-aid will be released in the name of Principal of DA Pandu Memorial RV Dental College, Bangalore subject to following terms and conditions mentioned hereunder.

1. The Principal / Head of Institution shall open a separate joint account for the financial grant released by RGUHS in the name of Principal / Head of the Institution and the Principal Investigator.
2. Principal / Head of the Institution and the Principal Investigator shall be responsible for the accounts and the proper utilization of the funds. The grants released shall be used only for research purpose.
3. 50% of the grant-in-aid approved by RGUHS shall be released as 1st installment. 25% of the grant-in-aid shall be released after the Utilization Certificate for the money released in the 1st installment is given. 15. After the completion of the project the entire project report shall be submitted to the University and will become property of the University.
16. If any of the conditions mentioned above are not adhered to by the Principal/ Head of the Institution and the Principal Investigator, University reserves the right to take appropriate action.




