Report on the CDE program conducted on 04.09.2018

The Department of Prosthodontics organised a CDE program on 'Comprehensive Interdisciplinary Treatment Planning – A Prosthodontic Perspective' on 04.09.2018 in the II floor auditorium of DAPMRV Dental College and Hospital, Bangalore. The speaker for the program was Dr Druthil Belur, an alumnus of our college. Dr Druthil Belur completed his BDS from our institution, DMD from Boston University and his MS in Prosthodontics from the Baylor College of Dentistry, Texas.


We had a total of 195 registrations for the program that included both students and faculty (114 from other colleges and 81 from our college)


The program started at 9:15 am with a brief inauguration that included an invocation song, lighting of the lamp and introduction to the speaker and the program by our Principal Dr Asha R Iyengar and the Head of the Department of Prosthodontics, Dr J Sridevi. Dr Druthil Belur shared his knowledge and expertise on the interdisciplinary treatment planning of a complex prosthodontic case. It was a very fruitful interactive session. After a short tea break Dr Dhrutil Belur presented various cases that he had treated which included full mouth rehabilitations, partial fixed dental prostheses, esthetic rehabilitations, all of which highlighted the importance of digital dentistry.

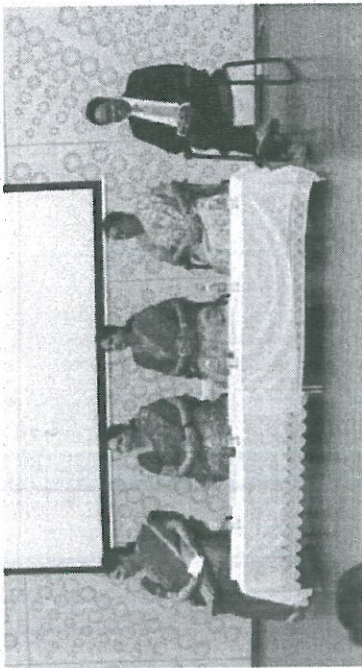
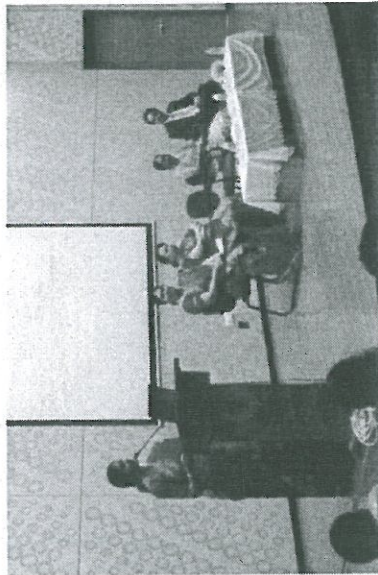
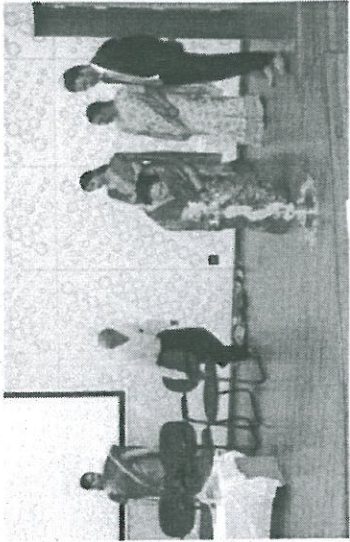
