**Department of Oral Medicine and Radiology**

**Criteria 4.1.1: Facilities for clinical learning**

The department is well equipped with state of the art diagnostic and therapeutic equipments which also aid the student in learning the required set of clinical skills.

**Cone beam computed tomography (CBCT unit)**

The department acquired a CBCT unit from J. Morita Mfg Corp, Kyoto, Japan. This state of art unit comes from a reputed Japanese company who are the pioneers in CBCT technology. The unit comes with a multiple FOV choice which significantly reduces the radiation dose to the patient. CBCT scans give a 3 dimensional perspective of the patient's pathology. Reconstruction algorithms of the unit construct the image in axial, sagittal and coronal planes which helps in better understating of the pathology/anatomy. Apart from routine information of the teeth and associated structures, the unit also helps in airway analysis, implant planning surgical stent preparation and model scanning. In future this unit can be integrated with 3D printing technology. Also the CBCT images are used in teaching learning process of oral medicine and radiology. Postgraduate students learn the nuances of CBCT image interpretation which is an important task in the diagnostic workup of a number of dental procedures like implant planning, 3<sup>rd</sup> molar surgery etc.

**Panoramic radiography unit**

The department is equipped with a digital panoramic radiographic machine manufactured by Kodak 8000C from Carestream Health India Ltd. The digital unit is supported by a workstation and is attached to a laser printer for printing the images. Apart from routine panoramic and cephalometric images, these machines are also used for taking skull radiographs, lateral TMJ radiographs, maxillary sinus views and radiographs for assessment of implant sites. A number of departments in the institution have utilized these machines for conduct of their research work. The unit is aslo useful as an effective learning tool for the students. The undergraduate students are taught about the hard tissue pathology involving the maxillofacial skeleton using these images. The interns have a quota of taking and interpreting 5 panoramic and extraoral radiogrphahs.

**Intraoral periapical radiography unit**

The department is equipped with three intraoral radiography units. Two machines are manufactured by Carestream Health India Ltd The newer 3<sup>rd</sup> machine was acquired in March 2019 from J Morita Mfg Corp, Kyoto Japan. The uniqueness of this intra oral radiography unit lies in its compact design and laser lights which indicate the point of entry of the X ray beam and hence can be used as useful tool for demonstration of radiographic techniques espwcially for the undergraduate students. The department is equipped with Digoraoptime PSP based digital imaging system which has 6 different size sensors with the help of which digital intraoral images can be obtained. This system also has features of zooming of the images, clarity and contrast modification, measurement of the tooth length and angulation, three-dimensional visualization, colouring, inversion, subtraction of images, storage and retrieval of images. This system eliminates the usage of the radiographic

allowing storage of images by way of hard or soft copy and the images can be sent to distant places through tele radiography.

### **TENS machine**

The department is equipped with two Transcutaneous Electric Nerve Stimulation (TENS) machines. . TENS therapy is an integral part of the pain clinic in the department. TENS is routinely used in management of painful muscle conditions particularly the maxillofacial musculature. The machine has both muscle stimulation (physiostim) and TENS (physiotens) options. The machine delivers low intensity electric current to the patient through electrodes that is placed on the painful areas. The machine has a dial gauge each for indicating the intensity and frequency of the current.





**Pre-Clinical Laboratory:**


The Under Graduates and the Post Graduates students are trained to refine their skills and given a thorough pre clinical training before their direct clinical exposure. The students are encouraged to make the charts and models related to the operative dentistry and endodontics which gives them the basic idea to simulate and correlate with the subject. The under graduate students are instructed to work on the plaster models, extracted teeth and the typhodonts as per the DCI and RGUHS guidelines. The phantom head with work station (30 Nos in the under-graduate and 8 Nos post-graduate) mimics the natural scenario for a complete pre-clinical training. The quota of work in preclinical operative dentistry for under graduate students includes:

1. Preparation of Class I, II, III, IV, V, VI cavities, base and matrix band application, silver amalgam and Glass Ionomer cement restorations; Inlay cavity preparations and their wax patterns.
2. Manipulation of dental cements understanding the properties, consistency and the mixing and setting times.
3. Endodontic preclinical work includes root canal treatment of the single and multi rooted extracted teeth.

The post graduate pre clinical training includes

1. Wax carving of the maxillary and mandibular teeth which makes them understand the basic anatomy and the tooth morphology.
2. Sectioning of Permanent teeth.
3. Operative work includes the conservative, conventional Class I cavities, class II cavities and its modifications and silver amalgam restorations; Cavity preparations and wax patterns for the direct and indirect restorations. Tooth preparations for the full metal, PFM and ceramic crowns and their wax patterns and casting.
4. Endodontic preclinical work includes Root Canal Treatment of single and multi rooted teeth along with the respective radiographs. Post and core preparations for fibre post and the cast post.

Further, special attention is provided to the students with different learning abilities by guiding them to do extra work which enables them to gain the required confidence to proceed with the routine clinical work.

Department of Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry

The Department of Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry was established in 1993 with an undergraduate program and currently trains 60 students every year. The Postgraduate program in the specialty was started in 2003 and presently has an intake of 3 students per year. The Department was also recognized as a PhD centre in 2018. The department provides comprehensive treatment for children from birth to adolescence (0-14 years) including those with Special Health Care Needs. Treatment under general anesthesia for children requiring extensive treatment is provided by the department at Sevakshetra Hospital which is attached to the college.

The department conducts School Oral Health programs on a public-private-partnership model which has been recognized by the World Health Organization. This caters to needy school children in both urban and rural settings and provides free dental check up and treatment to approximately 15,000 children every year. On site treatment is provided with the help of a Mobile Dental Van with two chairs as well as portable dental units that help us to simultaneously treat several children. This has led us also to several innovative practices including a powerless pump for scalers. The program provides both undergraduate and postgraduate students a vital connect with the society, its needs and trains them in executing such community-based dental camps.

The department has industrial ties including Vittal Mallya Research Foundation and Hindustan Unilever Limited for various research projects. This is critical for the ongoing research training of our postgraduate and doctoral students.

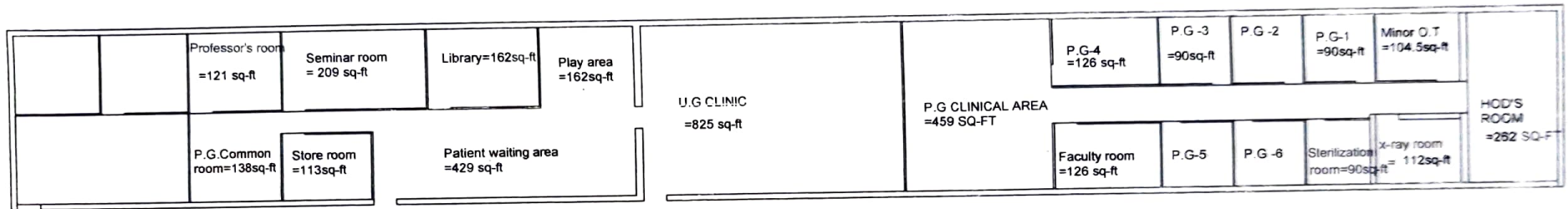

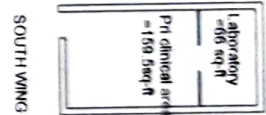

The department of Prosthodontics has an extensive set up with 9969 Sq Ft area spread over three floors to cater academic training and development of the students.

We have state of the art Preclinical lab for the undergraduates with phantom heads, airtor and 3 way syringe connection. The post graduate lab is well equipped with the latest instruments and equipments to train in post graduates in Preclinical work, ceramic and casting procedure for crowns, bridges and cast partial dentures as well as advanced technology like pressable ceramic work and fluid resin techniques. There is a lab attached to the UG/PG clinic which is very convenient for the students and faculty during clinical procedure. We have a total of 36 dental chairs in the clinics, which is in constant use by the students to cater the patient. Gas lines have been set up in the clinics also to enable chair side work. We have an intra oral X-ray machine also installed in the department. There is an exclusive sterilization room with autoclaves installed to sterilize the instruments used by the students (PGs and UGs) and the faculty.

The department of Prosthodontics has a seminar room that can house the PGs and faculty for seminar and journal club presentations and clinical case discussions.

We have a self sufficient dept library with the latest books. There are a total of 243 books. In addition to this we also have CDs, copies of the PG students' seminars, main dissertations, library dissertations and profile books that can be borrowed from the library. We also have 13 complimentary books.




