CAMP & HOSPITAL DETAILS:

- The Department of Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry under the guidance of Dr.Anantharaj, Prof & HOD, conducted a School Dental Health Camps at various places in and around Bangalore, Kanakapura and at Hosur, Tuticorin and Tirunelveli Districts of Tamil Nadu during the period from 1st September 2014 to 16th March 2015. A total of 14,011 children from 32 schools and 2 special schools mentally challenged, visually impaired and deaf and dumb school children. They have been treated with restorative procedures, scaling and preventive restorations and health education.
- The Department of Public Health Dentistry under the guidance of Dr.A.G.Harikiran, Prof & HOD, has conducted 15 camps and treated 1661 patients in camps during the period from September 2014 to March 2015.


