Sub: Approval Budget Estimates for the year 2014-15 in respect of

With reference to the above, the budget estimates of the institution cited above for the financial year 2014-15 is hereby approved by the Trust with the following observations. The copy of the approved budget is sent herewith for office record purpose.

- No expenditure should be incurred without adequate budget provision. Cases not covered by the budget provision should be referred to Trust before incurring expenditure. The expenditure should not exceed the budget allotment under any head of account. Prior approval of Trust should be obtained in cases exceeding the budget.
- There should not be diversion of budget allotment from one head to another to meet any deficiency without prior approval of the Trust. Budget control Register should be maintained for all heads of account reflected in the budget and made available to the Trust as and when required.
- Approval of Trust should be obtained before resorting to any Capital purchases so also in respect of Revenue expenditure. Proposal of purchases should indicate details of budget allotment as approved by Trust, expenditure incurred up to that date, department to which the purchases have to be made, full justification for making purchases etc., and also accompany quotation obtained from not less than 3 to 4 suppliers.
- 4. The half yearly Income & expenditure statement to end of September 2014 against the budgetary allocation may be furnished to the Trust office on or before 15.10.2014 as per the budget format. The necessary reasons/justifications/explanations may also be furnished for non spending/excess spending of the budgetary allocations/income anticipated.
- While review of budget proposals sent by the institutions, it is observed that the revenue expenditure is increasing affecting the financial viability of the institution itself. Hence, the HOI should take necessary action in reducing the following expenditures to the possible extent.
  - (a) Expenditure in expensive printing and stationery including invitations etc
  - (b) Food and catering expenses at all functions and programs.
  - (c) In photographic expenses, the photos shall be taken only in soft copies, with minimum printing for display.
  - (d) Unnecessary consumption of papers for drafts and copies.
  - (e) Unnecessary procurement of library books just because budget exists.
  - (f) All other revenue expenditures wherever possibility of minimizing the same.
